

1.04 CLERK TREASURER

- (1) The Village of Hilbert hereby elects that all provisions of Section 62.09 (3) (b) and (c) of the Wisconsin Statutes relating to the offices of clerk and treasurer and the method of selection and tenure thereof in conflict with this ordinance shall be inapplicable to the Village of Hilbert.
- (2) The offices of clerk and treasurer are herewith combined. The Clerk-Treasurer shall be appointed by two-thirds vote of all members of the Village Board and shall hold office for an indefinite term, subject to Section 17.12 (1)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes.
- (3) Prior to any appointment of the Clerk-Treasurer, all candidates for that office shall be examined by a committee of three persons designated by the President. Each candidate shall file an application stating in detail their education, experience and other qualifications. The committee shall provide for additional tests to ascertain the fitness of each candidate. The Committee shall submit to the Village Board a written report of the qualifications of each candidate, indicating their numerical rating based on the application and test which shall be filed in the office of the clerk and open for examination but not transcribing. The appointment by the Board shall be from the three persons ranking the highest on such reports.
