

4.07 ADDITIONAL STATE TRAFFIC LAWS ADOPTED

(1) Except as otherwise specifically provided in this code, the statutory provisions in Chapters 340 to 348 and Section 940.01, of the Wisconsin Statutes, describing and defining regulations with respect to vehicles and traffic, exclusive of any therein relating to penalties to be imposed and exclusive of any regulations for which the statutory penalty is a fine or term of imprisonment are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this code as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any statute incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this code. Any future amendments, revisions, or modifications of the statutes incorporated herein are intended to be made part of this code in order to secure uniform statewide regulation of traffic on the highways, streets, and alleys of the State of Wisconsin.

(2) Penalty for violation of this ordinance shall be controlled by Section 15.01 of this Code.
