

## 6.02 ALCOHOL IN PUBLIC PLACES

(1) POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL BEVERAGES IN PUBLIC PLACES. No person shall consume or possess any open can, bottle, or other container containing malt beverages or intoxicating liquor on any public way, public street, sidewalk, parkway, safety zone, alley or public parking lot, or on and/or in any motor vehicle parked on a public way, public street, alley, or public parking lot in the Village of Hilbert, or within 300 feet of any tavern holding a retail license for the sale of fermented malt beverages or for the sale of intoxicating liquors as defined in Wisconsin Statutes of the Village of Hilbert, except that fermented malt beverages may be consumed on the premises on which a picnic is being held for which a Picnic Class B license has been issued by the Village of Hilbert only during those hours which fermented malt beverages are sold pursuant to said Picnic Class B license.

(2) PENALTY. Penalty for violation of this ordinance shall be controlled by Ordinance No. 15.01.
