FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD--

Highlights of the June Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- *To allow Scott's Bar & Grill to host an outdoor concert and pig roast on July 3rd.
- *To grant licenses for the upcoming licensing year.
- *Payment Request #6 to Water Well Solutions for \$13,775.
- *Conditionally granted the Class B License to La Union, LLC based upon satisfying the 15 day waiting period.
- *Granted a Temporary Class B License to St. Mary's Congregation for the Cheese Derby.
- *Granted a Temporary Class B License to Hilbert Volunteer Fire Department for their annual 4th of July picnic.
- *Approved granting a raise of \$.50 per hour to Brandon Strelow after successfully satisfying his probationary period.
- *Approved spending \$1,800 to install sealing manhole covers on the manholes on Highway 57/32 where the flooding occurred.
- *Resolution 2012-01 approving the submittal of the annual CMAR report for the wastewater treatment plant.

The village board received notification of the following:

- *Notice of a donation of \$1,500 to the first responder group from the Sharon Janke Charitable Fund. These funds will be set aside for future defibrillator purchases.
- *Notice of a donation of \$1,000 to the fire department from the Sharon Janke Charitable Fund. These funds will be set aside for the purchase of new turnout gear for the department.
- *Bids will be opened for the Main St. waterline project on June 20th.
- *Report from the auditor on the village's audited financial statements for 2011. He stated that the village is in very good financial condition with a strong fund balance. He also stated that both TIF Districts had positive cash flow in 2011 as did both the water and sewer utility. He pointed out to the board that for a village of our size, we are in much stronger financial shape than a lot of other communities our size.
