Highlights of the September Board Meeting:

The Village Board approved the following:

- The request from Hilbert High School to host a bonfire on Thursday, September 26th as part of their homecoming week celebration.
- The application for an operator's license for Mahendra Basnet.
- A public hearing (if required) for special assessments for Fochs Trails Subdivision on Tuesday, October 8th at 7p.m. prior to the board meeting.
- To send Charlie Fochs and Kim Plate to the WWOA State Conference in Green Bay.
- To proceed with draining tile work at the ballfield in the amount of \$1,088.13.
- To sign a contract with Cedar Corporation to seek possible funding for the purchasing of Bel Brands Property.

The Village received notice of the following:

- Notice of Quarterly Cable TV Franchise Fees from Charter Communications in the amount of \$2,407.26.
- Notice of Net New Construction for 2019 from the WI Department of Revenue.
- Notice of 2019 TIF Limitation Report from the WI Department of Revenue.
- Notice from the Department of Administration regarding estimated 1/1/19 population of the Village. The estimation is 1,171 which is an increase of 3.4% (39 people) since the 2010 census.
