FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD--

Highlights of the March Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- *For the fire department to purchase budgeted items from the lowest priced vendor.
- *Operator licenses for Theresa Lewins and Heather Blohowiak.
- *Approved the request of the school district to install mobile community libraries in Civic Park and Railroad Park.
- *Approved for the fire department to do some minor improvements in the fire station with funds being paid by the department as they can afford and the remainder of the items would need to be budgeted for.
- *To purchase a Magikist Steamer that will be used for thawing out water laterals for a cost of \$2,641.

The village board received notification of the following:

- *Summary of garbage and recycling trends from 2006 – 2013. The tonnages of garbage have increased by about 9 ton while the amount of recycling has decreased by about 2 ton. This is something that was noted that needs to be monitored.
- * There was some information presented by the Revitalization Group on ideas on improving the looks of the village. The village will be having a meeting sometime in the near future to discuss these ideas. Please watch for the notice of this meeting at the places where notices are posted and also on our website. Any residents are encouraged to attend to provide their input regarding improving the looks of the village.
