## FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD--

### Highlights of the August Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- \*To allow the fire department to purchase 10 new sets of turnout gear at a cost of \$1,500 each and to purchase 10 new pairs of firemen boots at a cost of \$315 each.
- \*To allow a property split in the Town of Rantoul. This property is in the village's extraterritorial area of 1.5 miles.
- \*Operator licenses for Christopher Fiedler and Shekar Adhikari.
- \*Conditionally approve the Class A Liquor & Beer License for DB Petroleum, LLC based upon satisfying the 15 day waiting period.
- \*To place the Birch St. property up for sale for a price of \$22,000 and the buyer will pay for all legal fees associated with the sale.
- \*To allow the Village Hearthstone to close off Main St. from 5<sup>th</sup> St. to 3<sup>rd</sup> St. for their Annual Cruise-In & Dine Car Show on 9/15/12.
- \*To allow a fiber optic line to be installed to the water tower site to upgrade the Verizon Wireless cell site at the tower.

The village board received notification of the following:

- \*Notice of receipt of the quarterly Cable TV Franchise fees from Time Warner Cable in the amount of \$2,420.40.
- \*Notice of distribution of the First Dollar Credit in the amount of \$26,327.73.
- \*Notice of receipt of the July installment of Shared Revenue in the amount of \$65,093.48 and the July School Levy Tax Credit payment to the county in the amount of \$73,583.81.
- \*Notice of receipt of the exempt computer aid for real estate in the amount of \$451.00.
- \*Notice of receipt of the exempt computer aid for TID #1 in the amount of \$318.00 and TID #2 in the amount of \$542.00.
- \*Notice of current year equalized values. For the Village of Hilbert, we had an increase of equalized values of \$749,300 or 1.33%, while the county as a whole decreased by \$77,311,800 or 2.22%.
- \*Notice of Net New Construction for 2011-2012. The village had an increase of \$1,240,100 or 2.21% while the county had an increase of \$20,357,600 or .58%.
- \*Notice of the TID Value Limitation Worksheet Report. Current law states that all TID Districts must be less than 12% of the total equalized valuation of the village. Currently, our TID's account for 15.69% of our total equalized valuation. This means that right now, we could not create a new TID unless we terminated one of the other TID's.
