## FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD-- Highlights of the April Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- \*Payment Request #5 to Water Well Solutions for the Well #4 project.
- \*Change in agent for a Class B License for GTG Adventures, Inc. (Advanced Archery)
- \*Allowing the fire department to burn ditches and overgrown vegetation in various areas as part of their training.
- \*Sending Dennis DuPrey to the annual Clerk's convention in Madison.
- \*Sending Ken Stenklyft to the annual International Association of Arson Investigator's conference in Stevens Point.
- \*Allowing Amy Suha to attend an NFPA Code seminar.
- \*Awarding the contract to Kempen Excavating for \$9,488 to raze the building at 14 S. 7<sup>th</sup> St.
- \*Approved the recommendation from the Hilbert Housing Authority Board to keep Hilbert Manor a single unit project instead of making it a family unit project.
- \*Annual Appointments of citizens to various committees. They were as follows: Jesse Dohr, Mike Loose and Jim Koffarnus (board member representative) for the plan commission; Jim Pethan for the Board of Appeals; Don Richart for the Housing Authority Board.
- \*Conditionally approved the 6 month license for the Hilbert Athletic Association for the two ballfields.
- \*To bid out for the 2012 street projects
- \*To place chip seal on 12<sup>th</sup> St if funds are available.

The village board received notification of the following:

- \*Quarterly street aid payment in the amount of \$12,167.10
- \*Notice of lottery credit for mobile homes in the amount of \$3,123.84
- \*Notice of lottery credit for real estate in the amount of \$23,916.75.
- \*Condition of budgets for all funds
- \*Notice of 2012 Recycling Grant award in the amount of \$8,317.76.

Spring Clean – The annual Spring Clean where residents can dispose of larger ticket garbage items is scheduled for Saturday, May 5<sup>th</sup> from 8 a.m. – 11 a.m. As was the case as last year, the event will be a drop off event at the gravel parking lot across from the fire station/community center.
