PROGRAM UPDATE

One of the major announcements that came about this last quarter was the purchase of Advanced Disposal by Waste Management. The sale was final on October 30th. As part of this sale, Waste Management has sold certain assets of the merged company to GFL Environmental as of this date which includes the Village's collections service. They have assured us that it will be "business as usual" with the sale. Over the next several months you will see the transition to GFL but Waste Management/Advanced Disposal may still provide services as a subcontractor of GFL. We understand that all of this may sound confusing but they have assured us that there should be no interruptions in the services provided during this transition. If there are any issues, please do not hesitate to contact the clerk's office for assistance.

With the holiday season upon us, please keep in mind the banned items for landfills. One of the most common items that are replaced this time of year is electronics. With the current landfill ban, they are not allowed to be disposed with your regular garbage. There are several local businesses that will take electronics. Some of the businesses do charge a fee for disposing of the electronics which is never popular, but it is a far better option for the environment than it is to dispose these items. There are also avenues for donating your used cell phones so that they can be handed out to individuals who use them to call 911 when needed. Most cell phone retail outlets will take your old cell phones for this program. There will also be programs sponsored by the county for you to properly dispose of your electronics and hazardous materials. These are listed on the same page as the garbage and recycling pick up dates.

The Village is again picking up real Christmas trees after the holiday season to be recycled. The trees must be placed by the curb and all decorations, wires, bows, lights, etc. must be removed. If these guidelines are not followed, your tree will not be picked up. The deadline for picking up the trees will be **Monday, January 18, 2021**. No trees will be picked up after this time. The village employees will make every effort to pick up the trees in a timely manner but we are at the mercy of Mother Nature. We will not pick up Christmas Wreaths. Because of the amount of wires on them, we cannot chip them. Please dispose of them with your regular garbage. Any wreaths placed out on the curb will not be picked up.

If you have a damaged garbage or recycling container or wish to make changes, please contact the clerk's office. Do not contact the hauler directly.

COMPOST SITE

We ask that you continually take care of disposing compost material properly. There are signs at the site that instruct you which pile is the proper location to dump your compost material and brush. We accept brush up to 4" in diameter. If there is a need to have the brush picked up (this is for larger quantities only), we ask that you contact the clerk's office to get on the list. We also ask that you remove all root balls from the brush and bushes. We cannot run those through the chipper.

ANNUAL SPRING CLEAN AND TIRE RECYCLING

No dates have been set as of yet for the Annual Large Item disposal and tire recycling. Please watch our website, facebook page and future newsletters for more information on both of these events.
