FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD –

Highlights of the May Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- Operator's license for Heather Wik-DuBois.
- Application for a Temporary Class B License to the Hilbert Lions Club for the Community 4th of July Picnic.
- To proceed with the treatment of the pond in Fochs Trails Subdivision.
- To proceed with plans and estimates to install an iron removal filter system at Well #4 based upon the findings from the pilot study which was completed.
- To hire Clifton Larson to complete and submit a full rate case to the PSC including the Well #4 Project.
- To use a dark blue color for the replacement siding on the community center building.
- The formal collaborative agreement with the Eastshore Humane Association.
- Donation to the Eastshore Humane Association in the amount of \$1,072.38 from the village's share of the dog license fees.
- The request by Chief Loose to replace the tires on Truck #32.

The village received notice of the following:

- Notice of receipt of the 2019 Recycling Grant in the amount of \$8,325.12.
- Annual report for our recycling program; we are currently meeting all state requirements.
- Notice of receipt of Personal Property Aid (Real Estate) in the amount of \$3,262.77.
- Notice of receipt of Personal Property Aid (TIF Districts) in the amount of \$4,094.25.
