## FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD--

### Highlights of the February Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- \*Change Order #2 for a time extension for Water Well Solutions for the Well #4 project.
- \*Payment Request #3 to Water Well Solutions for the Well #4 Project.
- \*Operator License for Robert Davis
- \*Class B License for Officials Den Bowl & Spirits, LLC. This is for the property at 408 N. 8<sup>th</sup> St.
- \*Class B License for Champs Pub, LLC. This is for the property at 245 W. Main St.
- \*Funding to Calumet County for the 2012 Clean Sweep program in the amount of \$216.60.
- \*Sending Charlie to the annual Rural Water convention in Green Bay, March 27<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup>.
- \*Sending Charlie to an excavating safety training class at the community center on February 22<sup>nd</sup>.
- \*Sending Ken and any other board member interested in going to the policyholder meeting for LWMMI in Wisconsin Dells on April 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup>.
- \*Sending fire department members to the Wisconsin State Firefighters convention in Lake Geneva.
- \*Purchase of a walk behind saw from Tenor Supply for \$2,459.
- \*Purchase of a welder and helmet from Miller for \$1,543.20
- \*Purchase of a new lawnmower for the treatment plant from Gruett's for \$6,650.
- \*Allowing an outdoor wedding reception on the lot between 4<sup>th</sup> & Five and the Village Hearthstone on June 21<sup>st</sup>.

The village board received notification of the following:

- \*Notice of taxes collected to 1/31/12. A total of \$957,066.65 or 71.9% was collected compared to \$951,508.92 or 71.5% last year.
- \*Notice of receipt of the quarterly cable TV franchise fees in the amount of \$2,408.87.

Spring Clean – The annual Spring Clean where residents can dispose of larger ticket garbage items is scheduled for Saturday, May 5<sup>th</sup> from 8 a.m. – 11 a.m. As was the case as last year, the event will be a drop off event at the gravel parking lot across from the fire station/community center. There will be no curbside pickup. Residents will be responsible for getting the material to the drop off facility. Pick up at your residence will not be available. Hazardous household waste will not be part of this pickup. Please watch for your recycling newsletter which comes out in March for details on the program.
