FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD--

Highlights of the January Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- \*Change Order #1 for a time extension for Water Well Solutions for the Well #4 project.
- \*Payment Request #2 to Water Well Solutions for the Well #4 Project.
- \*Property split in the Town of Rantoul and Town of Chilton for property that lies within the village's extraterritorial jurisdiction.
- \*Sending Charlie, Josh & Brandon to schooling in Hilbert and Charlie & Josh to schooling in Kewaunee.
- \*Authorized the preparation of plans and specs for the upcoming 2012 projects.

The village board received notification of the following:

- \*Notice of taxes collected to 12/31/11. A total of \$578,158.61 or 41.6% was collected compared to \$508,825.30 or 36.7% last year.
- \*Notice of receipt of the quarterly street aid payment in the amount of \$12,208.37.

## 2012 ELECTIONS

The three incumbents up for reelection for the office of Village Trustee filed the required paperwork to be included on the April ballot. There were no other individuals that filed the necessary paperwork to be on the ballot. The three incumbents are Gary Boesch, Mark Breckheimer and Jim Koffarnus. As of right now, it appears that there will not be a primary election in 2012 in February but depending on the effort to recall the governor, there may be special elections in addition to the April election. Also for 2012, there will be elections in August and November.
