FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD--

Highlights of the July Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- *To allow the Hilbert Revitalization Group to host the Annual Cheesehead Run on August 25th and to allow them to block off Main St. from 3rd St – 4th St. during the race.
- *To issue to La Union, LLC a Reserve Class B grant in the amount of \$9,800.
- *Operator licenses for Joshua Diedrich, Conor Winarski, Melanie Dohr, Jodi Guyette, Karen Johnson, William Johnson, Jr. and Natasha Grenzer.
- *To allow CJF Estates to pay interest only payments on the outstanding special assessments for Fox Trails Subdivision for the next 3 years.
- *Conditionally awarding the contract for the water line replacement on Main St. between 4th St. & 5th St. to Michels Corporation for \$43,086.
- *To proceed with advertising and bidding of the Well #4 building. Bids will be opened on July 25th and awarded that night.
- *To contract for a drainage study with Robert E. Lee & Associates to look at ways for improving drainage to help minimize flooding. Cost of the study will be \$6,600.
- *To send Brandon to a groundwater supply class and to take the first test towards certification as a water operator.
- *To send Charlie to the WWOA conference in Wisconsin Dells.
- *To stay with the current health insurance plan and that the employees will increase their % share to 7.5%.
- *To allow Main St. Art Works to hold an art event involving metal pours on the concrete slab between the two buildings on Main St. The event will take place on July 28th.
- *To allow the Hilbert Athletic Club and Officials Den Bowl & Spirits to hold a softball tournament at the ballfields in August.

The village board received notification of the following:

- *Notice of receipt of the quarterly street aid payment from the State of Wisconsin in the amount of \$12,167.10.
- *Copy of the PEW Report on Public Pension Plans which show that the Wisconsin Retirement System is one of the strongest plans in the nation and the only one that is 100% funded.
- *Notice of receipt of the 2% fire dues from the state in the amount of \$2,096.95.
