FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD--

Highlights of the May Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- \*To replace the air conditioner at the treatment plant lab at a cost of \$1,975.00.
- \*A revised village board handbook.
- \*A revised Internet Use Policy to incorporate the use of facebook.
- \*To allow Scotty's Bar & Grill to hold an outdoor concert on 7/3/13.
- \*Ordinance 2013\_01 amending Section 7.04(4)(B) of the Code of Ordinances dealing with dogs and "backyard breeders".
- \*Ordinance 2013\_02 amending Section 9.06(5) of the Code of Ordinances dealing with the Property Maintenance Code to change the committee that enforces the code to the Improvements and Building Permits Committee.
- \*To remove the planters on Main St. The Park Committee will be working with the Revitalization Group to find alternatives.
- \*To install a swale west of 12<sup>th</sup> St. to help alleviate drainage issues there.
- \*To contract with Frontier Communications to move a fiber optic line that is in the way of some drainage improvements on the southwest side of the village.
- \*To approve expanding the Hilbert/Potter First Responder Coverage area to include the area of the Town of Chilton not currently covered and also the City of Chilton. The board received information that there are 8 additional responders that are already certified that would join the group with this expanded coverage area.
- \*Non-monetary amendment to the lease agreement with U.S. Cellular to incorporate the replacement antennas going on the water tower.
- \*To send the 3 fire chiefs to the fire chief's convention in Wisconsin Dells at a cost not to exceed the budget of \$1,550.00.

The village board received notification of the following:

- \*Notice of receipt of the quarterly Cable TV Franchise Fees in the amount of \$2,301.39.
- \*Annual Report on Recycling.
- \*Annual Report Form C to the Dept. of Revenue.

## REMEMBER WHEN CUTTING YOUR LAWNS!!!

No unauthorized person shall place, or cause to be placed, any debris of any nature whatsoever, junk, garbage, grass clippings, leaves or any other yard waste or other waste material, other than refuse placed on the terrace for collection, upon the streets, alleys, highways, public parks or other property not owned by him, or upon any body of water within the Village.

Any person violating this ordinance shall be required to forfeit \$15.00 plus the cost of removal.

## ***RESOLVE TO BE READY IN 2013***

The STATE OF WISCONSIN Division of Emergency Management has a program this year called RESOLVE TO BE READY IN 2013.

Get ready for emergencies by taking these important steps:

1. Get an emergency kit.
2. Make an emergency plan.
3. Be informed about the type of emergencies that can happen in Wisconsin and how to respond.
4. Have a NOAA emergency weather radio tuned in for immediate alerts to danger.
5. Have flashlights and extra batteries.
6. Having food, water, medications, first aid kit and battery powered radios with extra batteries is essential.

### ***FROM THE VILLAGE OF HILBERT EMERGENCY GOVERNMENT:***

It was brought to our attention after the power outage that the village experienced last year that there were residents in the village whose oxygen generator went empty and those needed oxygen couldn't call out for help because their telephones didn't work either. Because of HIPPA privacy laws, your health care provider cannot tell us who in our village falls under this situation. Because of this we are asking for your help. The village desires to make up a list of everyone in the village that is currently on oxygen. The goal desired here is that in the event of an electrical outage or other emergency, we can reference this list and make sure that we follow up with those individuals and provide assistance to ensure that their lives are not put at risk. Please contact the clerk's office at 920-853-3241 to have your name placed on the list. Also, in the event of an emergency and you need to reach someone after hours, the village's after hours or emergency number is 920-418-3272. We are looking to get all affected residents on the list so if you know someone or have a neighbor under this situation, please pass this information onto them so that they can contact the village.
