## Highlights of the December Board Meeting:

### The village board approved the following:

- Operator's license for Jamie Moxley.
- Temporary Class B License for St. Mary's Catholic School.
- 2019 Lease Agreements for the Welcome to Hilbert Signs.
- Appointment of Andy King as the village's attorney for 2019.
- Resolution 2018\_09 declaring public depositories for 2019.
- Resolution 2018\_10 to place 2018 budgeted items not being expensed before year end to respective reserve funds.
- The village insurance renewal for 2019.
- Conditional approval of the certified survey map for the property split for Frontier, Inc.
- The certified survey map for the property split for St. Vincent Depaul.

### The village received notice of the following:

- Notice of the receipt of the 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of shared revenue in the amount of \$333,540.48.
- Notice of current year lottery credit in the amount of \$200.14.
- Notice of current year first dollar credit in the amount of \$82.41.
- Notice of current year state school tax credit in the amount of \$128,203.55 and estimated aid of \$1,339,992.00.
- Notice of receipt of the quarterly cable tv franchise fees in the amount of \$2,470.99.
