The Brillion Nature Center is located with the 4,800-acre Brillion State Wildlife Area. The property contains 6.5-miles of wood chip and limestone trails through prairie, marsh and woodland habitats for walking, running, hiking, cross-country skiing (un-groomed trails) or snowshoeing. Canoeing is also allowed in the Manitowoc River.
