FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD –

Highlights of the October Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- The First Responder contract amounts for 2019.
- The 2019 fire contracts.
- The 2019 compensation package for the fire department.
- The 2019 compensation package for village employees.
- To raise the garbage containers charge by \$5 each per year and the recycling containers charge by \$7 each per year.
- To submit a 2019 Recycling Grant.
- To set the public hearing date for the 2019 budget for November 13th @ 7 p.m.
- Temporary Class B License to the Hilbert/Potter Optimist Club for their annual bingo bash in November.
- Resolution 2018-06 which is to adopt the Village of Hilbert Village-Wide Development Plan.
- Resolution 2018-07 regarding supporting a sustainable solution to fund Wisconsin's Transportation System.
- Resolution 2018-08 regarding supporting the passage of legislation to close the dark store loopholes.
- Ordinance 2018-01 which is to allow the use of golf carts within the village.
- Ordinance 2018-02 which is to allow the use of ATV's/UTV's within the village.
- The purchase of 8 signs regarding the use of golf carts/ATV's/UTV's to be posted at designated locations.
- Request by Charlie Fochs to proceed with the sludge storage building roof in the amount of \$18,000.00 as budgeted.

The village received notice of the following:

- Notice of receipt of the quarterly street aid payment in the amount of \$11,566.26.
- Notice of revised 2nd installment of shared revenue for 2018 in the amount of \$333,540.48.
- Notice of estimated street aid for 2019 in the amount of \$45,566.39.
- Notice of estimated shared revenue for 2019 in the amount of \$404,836.93.

2019 BUDGET

The proposed budget for all funds was presented to the board. DuPrey explained the factors within this budget. These were discussed at length. In the end, the village board felt that we would need to take some funds from our unrestricted fund balance to meet the needs of the village. It was decided that approximately \$54,480 would be needed; with \$37,910 taken from the General Fund and \$16,570 taken from the Capital Improvements Fund. Copies of the proposed budget are available by contacting the clerk's office. The details are as follows: Total Expenses – \$1,220,728.00

Total Tax Levy – \$402,843.00

Estimated Tax Rate - \$7.7400040 compared to \$7.9401787 last year or a decrease of \$0.20 per thousand.
