FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD--

Highlights of the January Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- *To send Charlie & Josh J. to an O&M Refresher course at the Hilbert Community Center on 1/21/14.
- *To send Charlie to a Biosolid Seminar in Stevens Point on 3/18/14.
- *To send Charlie to the WRWA conference in Green Bay on March 25th – March 28th.
- *Authorized the completion of plans and specifications for the upcoming 2014 street projects.

The village board received notification of the following:

- *Notice of receipt of the quarterly street aid payment in the amount of \$12,958.77.
- *Report on the taxes collected through 12/31/13. The total collected was \$503,612.70 or 33% of the tax roll compared to \$564,884.24 or 41.3% last year.

SUMMER HELP POSITION

The Village of Hilbert is seeking one individual for the position of summer help. Interested applicants will work outdoors (cutting grass, trimming weeds, painting, collecting refuse, picking up brush, park and ballfield duties and any other duties as assigned.) All applicants must hold a valid Wisconsin Drivers License and be at least 18 years of age. Rate of pay is \$9.00 per hour. Normal work schedule is 7 a.m. – noon; 1 p.m. – 4 p.m., Monday – Friday. Interested applicants must submit a village employment application to the clerk's office no later than 4 p.m. on Monday, February 10, 2014. Emailed applications will not be accepted. Employment applications are available from the clerk's office at 26 N. 6th St. or on our website at www.villageofhilbert.com under the employment section.

DAMAGED GARBAGE CONTAINERS

If you have a garbage container that is damaged and needs to be replaced, you can contact customer service at Advanced Disposal directly at 1-888-688-4005. You will need to provide them with your name, address and container size. They should then provide you with instructions for the container exchange. As long as the containers are being replaced under normal conditions, there will be no additional charge to replace the them. If the containers are damaged due to negligence or are lost, they will charge us a fee to replace them and that fee will be passed onto the customer. If there are any issues with the garbage pickup, recycling pickup or replacing damaged containers and the issues cannot be resolved with their customer service department, please contact the clerk's office for assistance.

WINTER PARKING & SNOW REMOVAL REGULATIONS

Please remember that we do have ordinances regarding overnight parking, removing snow and ice from sidewalks and placing snow into the roads. The codes are listed below:

(E) SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL

Residents of the village shall be required to remove snow and ice on street sidewalks and driveway entrances within 24 hours after a snowfall, sleet or drifting. If the owner or occupant has not cleared the sidewalk or driveway entrance within this time, the Director of Public Works shall have the Village clerk contact the homeowner or occupant and notify them of this ordinance. If the owner or occupant does not take action to clear the sidewalk or driveway entrance within 24 hours, the Director of Public Works shall have the sidewalk and driveway entrance cleared at the owner's expense. If the owner or occupant of any residence is so notified once during a single snow season, no further notification shall be required upon the subsequent occurrence of a snowfall, sleet or drifting, and the Director of Public Works shall have the sidewalk and driveway entrance cleared within 24 hours. The cost of clearing the sidewalk and driveway entrance shall be \$.60 per lineal foot.

(F) SNOW ON STREETS.

No person in clearing snow from their lots, sidewalks, driveways, filling stations, garages or other areas shall pile or distribute snow in the street alleyway or any portion of the street right of way, within the Village which in any way tends to narrow the traveled portion of the street, block the vision of motorists at intersections, prevent parking at the curb, or in any other way impede snow removal or create a traffic hazard. Persons having such an accumulation of snow shall remove the same at their own expense without depositing the same in the public streets or public right of way. Any person violating Section 5.04(F) shall be required to forfeit \$15.00 plus the cost of removal.

7. OVERNIGHT PARKING.

No person shall park or leave standing any vehicle or equipment upon any of the streets or alleyways of the Village of Hilbert between 3 a.m. and 7 a.m.; commencing November 15 and extending to April 15, except physicians on emergency calls.

We have had some issues with people not cleaning sidewalks adequately after storms or blowing snow into the roadways. If you are not properly cleaning your sidewalks, please do so because citations will be issued and the cost of removing it will be billed out. Also if you are blowing snow into the roadway, please no longer do this because citations will be issued and the cost of removing the snow will be billed out. Let's ALL do our part to keep the sidewalks and roadways safe for travel!!!
