Highlights of the May Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- \*Sending Dennis DuPrey to the annual Wisconsin Municipal Clerk's Association conference in Schofield in August.
- \*Sending Mike Loose and Dave Franz to the State Fire Chief's annual conference in Milwaukee.
- \*Temporary Class B License to Calumet Sno Trails for the annual Cheese Derby.
- \*Resolution #2014-01 declaring our official intent to reimburse expenditures as it relates to the planned WWTP upgrade.
- \*Resolution #2014-02 to appoint authorized representatives to file applications for financial assistance from the State of Wisconsin Environmental Improvement Fund as it relates to the planned WWTP upgrade.
- \*The facility plan for the planned WWTP upgrade.
- \*To proceed with the project to replace the Interceptor Sewer Main that runs to the WWTP.
- \*The engineering contract for the WWTP upgrade.
- \*The engineering contract for the facility plan/design of the Interceptor Sewer Main Replacement project.
- \*Awarding the bid for the 2014 paving projects to MCC in the amount of \$132,373.37.
- \*Appointment of Phil Nett to the Joint Review Board.
