FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD--

Highlights of the April Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- *Ordinance 2014_01 amending the property maintenance ordinance.
- *Other annual appointments to citizen committees. They were as follows: Plan Commission – Jim Koffarnus, Mike Loose and Paul Gehl; TIF Committee – Matt Kloehn; Board of Appeals – Dennis DuPrey and Glenn Cummings; Hilbert Housing Authority – Marjorie Thiel.
- *Operator license to Tory Walter
- *Temporary Class B License to the Hilbert Volunteer Fire Dept. for their End of Summer Celebration in August.
- *Conditionally approve the 6-month Class B license for the Hilbert Athletic Club based upon satisfying the 15 day waiting period.
- *Approved an amended policy on schooling/seminars.
- *To allow Dennis DuPrey to attend the Wisconsin Clerks, Treasurer's and Finance Officers conference in Manitowoc in June.
- *To allow Josh Jetton to attend a cross connection control class in June.
- *To have Schenck SC conduct a sewer user charge study as part of a planned wastewater treatment plan upgrade.
