FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD--  
Highlights of the March Board Meeting:

**The village board approved the following:**

- A conditional motion, pending closing of the purchase, to set the allowable acreage for renting land in 2017 to Schneider Farms.
- The resolution to place the land rental proceeds from the former Schneider Farms land into a reserve fund to help offset future infrastructure costs to develop the area.
- To approve the proposal of the loan from Collins State Bank for the purchase of the Schneider Farms land.
- To approve the contract with the Hilbert School District regarding High School baseball/softball – with no changes from the prior contract.
- To change the policy of the equipment use pertaining to the ball field maintenance.
- The installation of the new fence for the new baseball field. The base amount was \$22,932.00. Anything above that amount will be the responsibility of the Hilbert Athletic Association.
- The request from the Hilbert Revitalization Group to hold the annual Cheesehead Run on Saturday, August 19<sup>th</sup>.
- Donation of \$250.00 to Eastshore Humane Society.
