FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD -

Highlights of the April Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- Application for 6-month class B license for the Hilbert Athletic Association.
- Appointment of Board Standing Committees and other annual appointments.
- The formal collaborative agreement with the Eastshore Humane Association.
- Donation to the Eastshore Humane Association in the amount of \$1,109.59 from the village's share of the dog license fees.
- The moving of up to 3 power poles for the Hwy 114 (W. Main Street) Urbanization Project.
- The contract with Cedar Corporation for economic development assistance.
- Final payment request to Lane Tank Company, Inc. in the amount of \$7,541.87 for the Water Tower Recoating Project.
- The request to hire Brett Halderson to upgrade the village website not to exceed \$1,000.00.
- Operator's license for Kerry Herriot and Ginger Oberjat.
- To have Dennis DuPrey attend the Economic Summit in Green Bay on July 16th.
- To hire Northern Fence to install 3 gates at the Hilbert Park in the amount of \$2,750.00 with funds coming from the Park Building Reserve Fund.
- The ballfield maintenance agreement with the Hilbert Athletic Association.
- To replace the chemical pump at the WWTP in the amount of \$1,960.00 as budgeted.
- To purchase a new portable probe for the WWTP not to exceed the amount of \$2,000.00 as budgeted.

The village received notice of the following:

- Lottery credit for Real Estate in the amount of \$39,679.22
- Lottery credit for Mobile Homes in the amount of \$3,223.59
- The receipt of the quarterly street aid payment in the amount of \$11,566.26
- The condition of budgets for all funds.
