FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD -

Highlights of the August Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- The application for an operator's license for Harley Johnson and Travis DeJardin.
- The committee's recommendation to install new sidewalks on both sides of 11th St. and install flashing crosswalk lights with a push button activation on the west of 11th St. at Hwy 114.
- The payment request to Peter's Concrete Co. in the amount of \$130,003.08 for the Hwy 114 Project.
- To purchase 8 lunch tables from the Hilbert School District for \$100. These will be used in our park in October.
- The request by Hilbert Art & Antiques, LLC to have outdoor music as part of the Rural Arts Roadtrip Event.
- The request by Charlie Fochs to proceed with the purchase of a belt conveyor for the new sludge storage building in the amount of \$7,768.86 as budgeted.
- Request by the Voices of Peace to block off Chestnut St. from 7th St. to 8th St. during the Gospel Fest.
- To proceed with the steps which need to be taken regarding the request to purchase village property.

The village received notice of the following:

- The notice of the July installment of Shared Revenue in the amount of \$58,838.30.
- The notice of the July School Property Tax Credit Payment to the county in the amount of \$119,793.86.
- The notice of the July First Dollar Credit Payment to the county in the amount of \$34,756.61.
