PROGRAM UPDATE

As we come near to the end of another holiday season, please keep in mind that all electronics are banned from the landfill and cannot be disposed with the regular garbage. There are several local businesses that will take electronics. Some of the businesses do charge a fee for disposing of the electronics which is never popular, but it is a far better option for the environment than it is to dispose these items. The garbage haulers do monitor the garbage as the carts are dumped and they can actually see if there are items being disposed that are prohibited such as electronics. There are also avenues for donating your used cell phones so that they can be given out to individuals that need them to call 911 when needed. Most cell phone retail outlets will take your old cell phones for this program. There will also be programs sponsored by the county for you to properly dispose of your electronics. These are listed on the same page as the garbage and recycling pick up dates. There will also be several hazardous wastes pick up dates sponsored by the county in 2020. I have listed these dates also with the other pick up schedules for easy reference. Please keep in mind that plastic bags are not recyclable. If there are ever questions on what is recyclable or not, please contact the clerk's office.

The Village is again picking up real Christmas trees after the holiday season to be chipped. The trees must be placed by the curb and all decorations, wires, bows, lights, etc. must be removed. If these guidelines are not followed, your tree will not be picked up. The deadline for picking up the trees will be **Monday, January 13, 2020**. No trees will be picked up after this time. The village employees will make every effort to pick up the trees in a timely manner but we are at the mercy of Mother Nature. We will not pick up Christmas Wreaths. Because of the amount of wires on them, we cannot chip them. Please dispose of them with your regular garbage. Any wreaths placed out on the curb will not be picked up.

Lastly, please keep in mind that if you have any damage to your garbage or recycling container, please contact the clerk's office in order to be placed on the list to either repair or replace the containers. All changes, repairs or replacements for the containers must run through the clerk's office. Do not contact the hauler directly.

COMPOST SITE

We ask that you continually take care of disposing compost material properly. There are signs down at the site that instruct you which pile is the proper location to dump your compost material and brush. Please make sure not to leave behind bags, boxes, etc. that you may have used to bring the compost material to the site. These items are supposed to be taken with you and disposed with your regular garbage. This has continued to be an issue and needs to improve. Please also remember that we can only accept brush up to 4" in diameter. If there is a need to have the brush picked up (this is for larger quantities only), we ask that you contact the clerk's office to get on the list. We also ask that you remove all root balls from the brush and bushes. We cannot run those through the chipper.

ANNUAL SPRING CLEAN AND TIRE RECYCLING

The Village will again be holding the Annual Spring Clean for large ticket items and also another tire recycling event is currently being planned. The date for the Annual Spring Clean will be Saturday, May 2, 2020 from 8 a.m. – 11 a.m. There has not been a specific date set as of yet for the tire recycling event.
