## FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD--

### Highlights of the June Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- \*Amendment to the recycling ordinance to better address compost site material being disposed at the site from non-residents.
- \*Licenses for beer, liquor, soda and cigarettes for the upcoming licensing year.
- \*Operator licenses for Stacy Bartel, Cheryl Sullivan and Whitney Krueger.
- \*Approving to send Dennis to the Clerk's convention in Milwaukee in August.
- \*The request to hold the Annual Cheesehead Run and to block off Main St. from 4<sup>th</sup> St. – 3<sup>rd</sup> St. on 8/24/13.
- \*To allow Scott's Bar & Grill to block off Chestnut St. from 8<sup>th</sup> St. – 9<sup>th</sup> St. for his outdoor band concert on 7/3/13.
- \*Approved several recommendations from the Improvements & Building Permits Committee regarding Property Maintenance violation letters that were sent.

The village board received notification of the following:

- \*Report on the Annual Board of Review. Real Estate increased by \$726,400 or 1.6%. Personal Property increased by \$37,490 or 4.15%. Overall, the total assessed values increased by \$763,890 or 1.65%.
- \*Josh McDonald reported that he passed his last sewer test and now a completely certified operator for the treatment plant.
- \*The 2012 Audit Report was presented to the board. The village currently has a very strong financial position and they would rate us in the upper 25% as far as financial strength compared to other municipalities our size. It was reported that we have a very strong fund balance which helps us if they continue to cut aids to municipalities.

### REMEMBER WHEN CUTTING YOUR LAWNS!!!

No unauthorized person shall place, or cause to be placed, any debris of any nature whatsoever, junk, garbage, grass clippings, leaves or any other yard waste or other waste material, other than refuse placed on the terrace for collection, upon the streets, alleys, highways, public parks or other property not owned by him, or upon any body of water within the Village. Any person violating this ordinance shall be required to forfeit \$15.00 plus the cost of removal.
