FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD –

Highlights of the April Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- Application for 6-month class B license for the Hilbert Athletic Association.
- The ballfield maintenance agreement with the Hilbert Athletic Association.
- To proceed with ballfield improvements which will be paid for by the Hilbert Athletic Association.
- The ballfield usage agreement with the school district.
- Appointment of Board Standing Committees and other annual appointments.
- To replace four door knobs with ADA lever handles for the community center building.
- To install changing tables in the bathrooms in the community center building.
- The reinstatement of Michael Loose at fire chief.
- The request from the fire department for the 3 fire chiefs to attend the fire chief's convention.
- For the fire department to sell cascade tanks in the amount of \$800.00.
- Awarding the bid for the 2019 road construction projects to MCC.
- To name the South Residential Property Development subdivision "Village Meadows".
- To name the first two streets of the South Residential Property Development subdivision "Thorn Creek Drive" and "Apple Blossom Drive".
- Resolution 2019-01 to Support for Fixing the State's Transportation Funding.
- Resolution 2019-02 to Support Shared Revenue Funding Increase.
- Resolution 2019-03 to Support for Increased Levy Limit Flexibility.
- Resolution 2019-04 to Support for Closing the Dark Store & Walgreens Loophole.
- To submit a counter (and final) offer to the Hilbert Revitalization Group for the old Hilbert Elementary School property with a deadline of April 26, 2019.

The village received notice of the following:

- Lottery credit for Mobile Homes in the amount of \$3,563.04.
- The receipt of the quarterly street aid payment in the amount of \$11,386.37.
- The condition of budgets for all funds.
